### **Staff Summary:**

The petitioner proposes installing an Electronic Variable Message Center (EVMS) sign at the Danville Town Hall that would replace the existing sign on the property. The maximum height allowed for a monument sign in the RU district is 5 feet and the proposed sign height is 7.2 feet.

Staff did not receive any inquiries following the certificate mailing to adjoining property owners.

Staff supports the variance request to increase the sign height by approximately 2 feet, as it will not impact safety and is essential to ensure sufficient visibility and functionality.

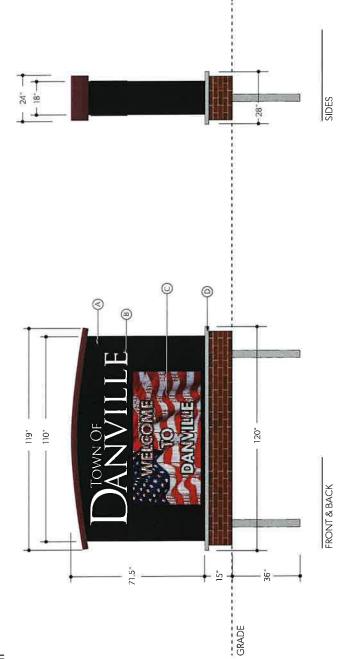

## FINDINGS OF FACT

### **DEVELOPMENT STANDARD VARIANCE**

Address: 49 North Wayne Street, Danville, IN 46122

1. The approval will not be injurious to the public health, safety, morals, and general welfare of the community.

The proposed sign is designed to enhance visibility and communication without compromising public safety. Its placement and construction will adhere to all applicable safety standards, ensuring it does not obstruct visibility or pose hazards to motorists and pedestrians.

2. The use and value of the area adjacent to the property included in the variance will not be affected in a substantially adverse manner.

The sign's design and placement are intended to complement the surrounding area, maintaining aesthetic consistency. There is no evidence to suggest that the increased height will negatively impact neighboring properties' use or value.

3. The strict application of the terms of the zoning ordinance will result in practical difficulties in the use of the property.

Due to the property's specific location and surrounding topography, adhering to the standard height limitation would render the sign less effective for its intended purpose. The additional height is necessary to ensure adequate visibility and functionality, addressing the unique circumstances of the site.
