

RESOLUTION NO. 4-2026

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF DANVILLE CIVIL TOWN, HENDRICKS COUNTY, INDIANA, AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF UNOBLIGATED FUND BALANCES TO THE FIRE PROTECTION TERRITORY GENERAL FUND.

WHEREAS, Danville Civil Town has entered into an agreement under IC 36-8-19 to establish the Danville-Center Township Fire Protection Territory effective January 1, 2026; and

WHEREAS, Danville Civil Town has been designated as the "Provider Unit" for said Territory and has established a Fire Protection Territory General Fund (Fund #2243) pursuant to IC 36-8-19-8; and

WHEREAS, IC 36-8-19-8.6 authorizes a participating unit to adopt a resolution to transfer any money belonging to the unit for fire protection purposes to the Territory's funds; and

WHEREAS, the Town currently maintains certain fund balances, including restricted donations previously received for fire protection purposes, which are now unused and unencumbered as the Town's independent fire department operations have been consolidated into the Territory; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that it is in the best interest of the Town and its residents to transfer these balances to the Territory to support ongoing fire protection services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF DANVILLE CIVIL TOWN, HENDRICKS COUNTY, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF TRANSFER The Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer the following unobligated cash balances to the Fire Protection Territory General Fund:

SECTION 2. TREATMENT OF DONATIONS The funds transferred from the Fire Donation Fund shall be designated as Restricted Funds within the Territory General Fund. These funds shall be used exclusively for the purposes originally intended by the donors and shall not revert to any general operating balance.

SECTION 3. STATUTORY COMPLIANCE Pursuant to IC 36-8-19-8.6, this Resolution identifies the specific amount of money transferred and the source of said money. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to the Provider Unit and maintained for audit purposes by the Indiana State Board of Accounts.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
