2025 Year-End Police Activity Report

Introduction

The Danville Police Department is proud to present its **2025 Year-End Police Activity Report** to the Danville Town Council. This report reflects the dedication and professionalism of our officers, detectives, and administrative personnel who continue to work tirelessly to protect the citizens of Danville and preserve the safety and quality of life within our community.

Throughout 2025, the department maintained a proactive approach to public safety, crime prevention, traffic enforcement, and investigative follow-up. The following data highlights the scope, volume, and impact of police services provided during the year.

Calls for Service and Case Activity

During calendar year 2025, the Danville Police Department responded to a total of **9,220 calls for service**, demonstrating the department's ongoing commitment to rapid response and community assistance.

- **Case Reports Completed:** 627
- **Total Arrests Made:** 313
 - **DUI Arrests:** 53
 - **Drug and Narcotics Arrests:** 25

These numbers reflect continued enforcement efforts focused on impaired driving, illegal drug activity, and public safety concerns.

Traffic Enforcement and Safety

Traffic enforcement remained a significant focus in 2025 aimed at reducing traffic accidents, impaired driving, and reckless behavior.

- **Traffic Stops Conducted:** 2,217
- **Vehicle Pursuits:** 16
- **Traffic Accidents Responded To:** 442
- **Warrants Served:** 108

Officers worked diligently to enhance roadway safety through targeted patrols and enforcement initiatives.

Community Policing and Public Safety Responses

The department responded to a wide range of community-related incidents, reinforcing its role as both law enforcement professionals and community partners:

- **Suspicious Persons Checked:** 222
- **Thefts Reported:** 100
- **Burglaries Reported:** 25
- **Domestic Disturbances:** 135
- **Disputes Between Individuals:** 630

These responses often require de-escalation, victim assistance, and problem-solving skills, underscoring the diverse nature of modern policing responsibilities.

Investigations Division Activity

The Investigations Division remained highly active throughout 2025, managing complex cases that require in-depth analysis and follow-up:

- **New Cases Assigned for Follow-Up:** 168
- **Death Investigations:** 26
- **Fraud Investigations Conducted:** 72
- **Department of Child Services Investigations Assisted:** 218

Detectives worked collaboratively with partner agencies to ensure thorough investigations and the protection of vulnerable populations.
