### Registering process:

Pre-register for an appointment at: scheduling.coronavirus.in.gov

On the first screen of registration site, choose "I don't have an Invitation Code".

The site is designed to find the closest community-based test site by zip code. Danville is 46122.

Appointments are made for 15-minute timeslots.

#### Notes:

Testing is available to all members of the public regardless of symptoms. Children as young as 2 years of age can be tested with parental consent.

Individuals should bring proof of Indiana residency, such as a state-issued ID, work ID, or utility bill.

There is no cost for COVID-19 testing at these sites.

For those interested due to travel, the tests are FDA/EUA-approved nucleic acid amplification tests (NAAT) and are processed at a CLIA-approved lab.

### Test results

Patients should receive their test results via text or email after 3 business days.

### If patient has not received their results after 3 business days:

Hendricks County residents may call the health department's COVID-19 Concerns line (317-718-6018).

If patient is not a Hendricks County resident, they may call the Indiana Department of Health's COVID-19 Call Center at 877-826-0011 and press 2. The call center is open 8am-5pm, Monday to Friday.
