Soft/Unsuitable soils were encountered per the attached Alt Witzig proofroll inspection report at main loop drive/road around new WTP. Per the discussions and direction of Alt Witzig and Banning Engineering we all agreed to proceed with the previously approved/established unit pricing for the additional excavation, geogrid, stone backfill, trucking/removal/disposal offsite at Owner provided dumpsite. The unit prices are inclusive of all markups, equipment, labor, material, etc. (#53 Stone \$75/Ton).

PROOFROLL INSPECTION

As per your request, our Senior Project Manager arrived at the above referenced jobsite to observe the present site soil conditions. These observations were limited to the soil subgrade for the proposed drive around the building.

To assist in our observations, a proofroll was conducted. A loaded tri-axle dump truck was utilized for the proofrolling operation. The truck was driven across the subgrade at a slow rate of speed. During this process, the subgrade was closely monitored for any indications of soft or unstable materials. The results indicated soft and unstable materials in six (6) locations. The areas were field marked for reference and are included on the attached diagram. The approximate locations and sizes are as follows:

- 1) South Entrance; 26' by 95'
- 2) Southeast Corner; 10' by 15'
- 3) East Side; 10' by 23'
- 4) Northeast Corner; 16' by 25'
- 5) North Side; 9' by 60'
- 6) North Entrance; 45' by 45' (Widest Dimension)

Areas 1-5

We recommend the exposed unstable subgrade areas be stabilized prior to the placement of the proposed crushed stone and asphalt section utilizing a geogrid mat and thickened stone subbase. The subgrade will require undercutting to allow for the installation of the proposed additional stone base materials and geogrid mat. We recommend the depth of the undercut to be a minimum of fourteen (14) inches.

Numerous projects have utilized geogrid mat systems to stabilize soft soil conditions. The geogrid (Tensar BX1200 or equivalent) should be placed over the materials at the base of the undercut.

The grid should be installed at the base of the undercut per the manufacturer's recommendations.

- Following installation of the geogrid, it is recommended that INDOT #53 crushed stone be placed over the grid and compacted per the project plans and specifications.
- The stone should be installed by back dumping the material at the edge of the geogrid and spreading the stone over the grid using a dozer or similar type equipment.
- Do not allow any equipment to run directly on the geogrid.
- No heavy traffic (trucks) shall be allowed across the grid area until a minimum covering of twelve (12) inches of stone is in place.

Area 6

Because of the soil conditions observed during our site visit, it is recommended that the area of soft and unstable materials in Area 6 be undercut by a minimum of twenty-four (24) inches below the design subgrade elevation. Upon removal, it is suggested to place a layer of #2 crushed limestone at the base of the undercut and "punch" the stone into the soils at the base of the undercut. Following the placement and consolidation of the #2 crushed limestone, it is recommended that the remainder of the undercut be re-established utilizing a geogrid mat such as Tensar BX1200 or equivalent, and INDOT #53 crushed limestone. The geogrid mat should be installed per the manufacturer's recommendations. The INDOT #53 crushed limestone should be placed and compacted in accordance with the project plans and specifications.

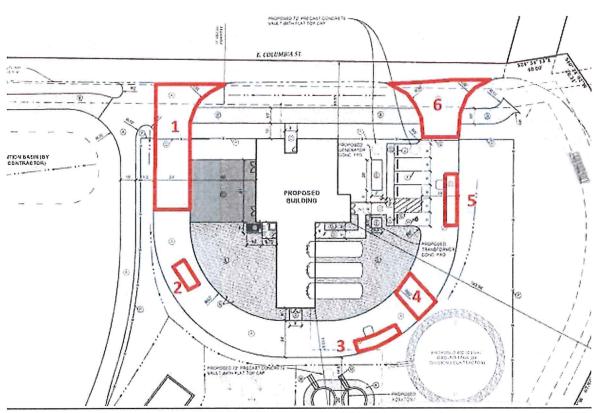
